Introduction

Youth Connections Provider, IN-STeP, is a not-for-profit community based organisation that helps 14-18 year olds gain the skills, experience and confidence to re-engage with education, training or employment.

Youth Connections links with schools, JSA's, TAFE's, RTO's, Youth service providers, Centrelink and self referrals to provide and assist Youth to improve their future prospects.

The aim of this brief is to map out how IN-STeP will provide this activity and what IN-STeP is trying to achieve by running it.

Program

IN-STeP aims to deliver a program that will encourage young people to develop skills to assist in Language, Literacy and Numeracy. The program will be tailored to suit the individual needs of the young person. The program could be contextualized to complement assessments and or assignments that are currently being undertaken by the young person. It will also incorporate comprehension for forms that can and maybe a part of general practice in life.

The program will include, however not be exclusive to:-

Applying for licence (motor vehicle, boat etc)
Vehicle Registration forms
Applying for banking accounts
Application for Medicare cards
Enrolment applications
Insurance claims
Position applications
Personal Audits
Map reading

Projected Outcomes

- Self esteem
- Personal skill development
- Improve career and life skill preparedness

Timing

This approach is geared to work as a continuous running program to work with young people as needs dictate to assist with the various requirements.

Summary

The Language, Literacy and Numeracy tutoring program offer by IN-STeP is geared to be tailored on an individual needs basis. The program offers assistance with daily life requirements which can vary from completing forms; assistance with school projects; to tailored programs to assist with developing basic literacy and/or numeracy ability.

The Youth Connections Program aims at re-engaging youth into education, training or employment. IN-STeP intends to achieve this service delivery via methods of fun learning activities, group tutorials and provision of individualised case management to overcome personal barriers.
